

RULEMAKING SUMMARY

Effective date: 07/01/06 unless otherwise noted.

Chapter 1 – Parks and Outdoor Recreation Lands and Waters

- Amend regulation #100 to:
 1. Clarify that the prohibition against littering applies to open waters.
 2. Require the handlers of dogs to pickup and remove animal waste.
 3. Delete the definitions of class “A” and “B” swim beaches.
 4. Rename Colorado River State Park to James M. Robb-Colorado River State Park.
 5. Clarify the Cheyenne Mountain food storage and preparation restrictions.
 6. Establish certain use restrictions for the East Canyon area of Castlewood Canyon SP.
- Amend regulation #103 to:
 1. Rename Colorado River State Park to James M. Robb-Colorado River State Park.
 2. Rename the portions of James M. Robb-Colorado River State Park where boating is either allowed or restricted.
 3. Clarify that Mack Mesa Reservoir is managed as part of Highline State Park.
 4. Allow the wearing of a Type V personal flotation device while tubing the Arkansas River within Pueblo State Park.
- Amend regulation #106 to rename State Forest to State Forest State Park.

Chapter 3 – River Outfitters

- Amend regulation #305 to correct a spelling error.

Chapter 7 - Passes, Permits and Registrations

- Amend regulation #700 to:
 1. Eliminate the \$3.00 daily vehicle pass provision for Harvey Gap, Sweitzer, Paonia, Mancos, and San Luis Lakes.
- Amend regulation #701 (**EFFECTIVE 01/01/07**) to:
 1. Provide for a \$3.00 individual daily “walk-in” pass fee year round for all persons 16 years of age or older who enter Eldorado Canyon, Colorado State Forest and Lory, except for persons entering these parks in a motor vehicle with a valid pass.
 2. Provide for a \$3.00 individual daily “walk-in” pass fee year round for all persons 16 years of age or older who enter the developed and posted fee sites of the Arkansas Headwaters Recreation Area, except for persons entering these parks in a motor vehicle with a valid pass.
 3. Allow for the sale of daily vehicle passes at the Arkansas Headwaters Recreation Area.
 4. Eliminate the individual daily “walk-in” pass at Cheyenne Mountain.
- Amend regulation #703 to correct spelling errors.

- Amend regulation #704 to:
 1. Redefine “Full-Hookup Campground” to mean that sanitary dump stations and laundry facilities may, as opposed to shall, be available at such campgrounds.
 2. Establish a two-night minimum stay requirement for the cabins at Mueller.
 3. Eliminate the \$2.00/night camping capacity fee charged during the high use season for certain campsites throughout the state park system. (*EFFECTIVE 01/01/07*)
 4. Establish a utility permit, the possession of which authorizes the holder to use dump stations and fill water holding tanks, both for noncommercial purposes, and specify that a valid park pass for the recreational vehicle is required in addition to the utility permit.
- Amend regulation #705 to delete an expired provision of the Aspen Leaf regulation.
- Amend regulation #706 to require a 25% cancellation fee for all group picnic area reservation cancellations made more than 14 days prior to the reserved date.
- Amend regulation #708 to:
 1. Rename the duplicate annual vehicle pass to replacement annual vehicle pass.
 2. Eliminate the \$3.00 daily vehicle pass for Harvey Gap, Sweitzer, Paonia, Mancos, and San Luis Lakes.
 3. Establish a \$20.00 fee for utility permits and prohibit the unlawful transfer, sale or assignment of utility permits.
 4. Provide for a \$3.00 individual daily “walk-in” pass fee year round for all persons 16 years of age or older who enter Eldorado Canyon, Colorado State Forest, Lory and the Arkansas Headwaters Recreation Area, except for persons entering these parks in a motor vehicle with a valid pass. (*EFFECTIVE 01/01/07*)
 5. Increase the campground-use permit fee by \$2.00/night for full-hookup, electrical and basic campgrounds and \$1.00/night for primitive campgrounds. (*EFFECTIVE 01/01/07*)
 6. Establish a fee schedule for the Mueller cabins of \$120/night for premium two bedrooms, \$180/night for premium three bedrooms, and \$240/night for premium four bedrooms.
 7. Restructure the event facility permit fee schedule in order to simplify the administration of those fees for event facilities at Castlewood Canyon and Golden Gate and add the event facilities at Lory to the fee schedule.
 8. Amend the cancellation fees for event facilities to match the cancellation fees for group picnic areas.
 9. Establish a conference/meeting room fee of \$100.00/day.
